Membership Categories

Active Members

Active members are Illinois firms engaged, in some manner, in the sale, installation or care of horticultural plants for the landscape. This includes growers, retailers, landscapers and irrigation contractors. There are three (3) levels of dues based on the company's gross revenues from the preceding year. All Active member firms are entitled to vote on association matters.

Allied Members

Allied members are manufacturers and distributors of horticultural equipment and supplies, industry support services, and out-of-state growers, retailers and landscapers. Dues are fixed. Please note: **Allied members are entitled to vote on association matters just as Active members are.** ALLIED MEMBERSHIP IS NOT AVAILABLE TO FIRMS ELIGIBLE FOR ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP.

Associate Members

Associate members are individual members. Employees of member firms, educators, government officials and others who are somehow associated with the green industry are eligible. Dues are fixed. ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP IS NOT AVAILABLE TO ANY PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR ACTIVE OR ALLIED MEMBERSHIP.

Retired Members

Retired Members are individuals that have officially sold their business or who are not actively engaged in day-to-day operations of the business, serving previously as an "active member" as set forth under the guidelines of active membership. Retired members shall be entitled to the privilege of the floor during open meetings but shall not be entitled to vote.

Student Members

Student Membership shall be for full time students studying horticulture. Student members are not entitled to vote.
